


Esparron Hermitage

Hermitage d'Esparron (Focus Outdoor)

A loop starting from Le Percy to discover the hermitage of Esparron, built in the 13th century which played also a role in the resistance during the 2nd World War.

A woodland itinerary overlooking the Perron valley as far as the hermitage and Esparron farm.


Trek

Departure : Percy

Arrival : Percy

1. From **Percy**, head towards **Esparron** via **Chabulière**, **Bayard** and **Sous l'Ermitage**.
2. From **Esparron**, follow signs to **Monestier-du-Percy**, via **Les Champs**, **Bois de Xavier**
3. In **La Selle**, then **Les Combes**, follow signs to **Monestier-du-Percy**, then **Le Percy**.



Transports

By train: Grenoble station or Clelles station Grenoble-Gap line
